What is a **TIA** (mini stroke)

A TIA is similar to a stroke but symptoms may only last a few minutes.

A TIA should be treated as an emergency. *Don't ignore it!* **Contact your GP TODAY.**

Signs of a TIA

Symptoms may include one or more of the following:

- weakness or clumsiness of hand, arm or leg
- difficulties with speech



- difficulties with swallowing
- numbness or pins and needles
- brief loss of vision, or double vision
- symptoms may last for 2-15 minutes but go completely in 24 hours
